What You'll Need to Get Started

- Student's Social Security Number (SSN)
- Parent(s)' SSN (if you're a dependent student) or spouse's SSN (if you're married)
- 2024 federal income tax returns for student and parent(s) or spouse (if applicable)
- W-2 forms and other records of money earned
- Bank statements
- Kennesaw State University FAFSA School Code: 001577

Pro tip: Create a folder or digital file to store all documents and stay organized!



Create Your FSA ID Your FSA ID is your login for the FAFSA.

- Both the student and at least one parent (if you are a dependent) or a spouse (if you are married) must create an FSA ID at studentaid.gov/fsa-id.
- Starting this year, you can email your parent(s) or spouse to invite them to be a contributor to your FAFSA and create their FSA ID.
- You'll need your full legal name, SSN, date of birth, and a personal email address.
- Choose a strong password and save it somewhere safe.
 You will use the same FSA ID and password every year.



Start Your FAFSA

- Go to **studentaid.gov**.
- Click "Start a New FAFSA" for 2026-2027.
- Log in using your FSA ID.
- Select Kennesaw State University (school code: 001577) to have your FAFSA sent directly to us.



Enter Your Financial Info

- Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to safely import your tax information.
- Provide income and tax details for yourself and your parent(s) (if dependent) or your spouse (if married).
- FAFSA uses your tax information from two years ago.
 For 2026-2027, use your 2024 tax return.



Sign and Submit

- The student and parent(s) (if applicable) or spouse (if applicable) must sign using their FSA IDs.
- Submit your application and be sure to save the confirmation page.

Double check: You're not finished until you see the confirmation screen!



Watch for Your FAFSA Submission Summary

- You'll receive an email once your FAFSA is processed. This usually takes 3 to 5 days.
- This email will include your Student Aid Index (SAI) and estimated financial aid eligibility.
- You may be asked to submit additional documents for verification (to confirm everything is correct).

Important: Review everything carefully. If there are any errors, you can log back in and make corrections.

Final Reminders from KSU

- We cannot send your financial aid offer until we receive your FAFSA.
- Check your Owl Express account and KSU email for any updates, or check your filing status at **studentaid.gov** under "My Activity."
- The FAFSA is always free. Never pay to submit it.
- Apply as early as possible! The 2026-2027 FAFSA opens October 1, 2025.
- Even if you think you won't qualify, submit the FAFSA anyway.
 Many scholarships require it.
