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This Program Level Agreement replaces previous “Exhibit G” dated December 19, 2025 and operates in conjunction with the Institutional MOU between KSU and Georgia Gwinnett College dated January 30, 2025.

Pathway Admission / Eligibility Requirements

- 1. The student may apply in the spring semester of the junior year or after completing 75 hours at the partner institution.
- 2. Undergraduate GPA of 3.25
- 3. The student may begin to take courses at KSU upon completion of 90 hours at the partner institution.
- 4. The student must have completed ITEC 2140 – Programming Fundamentals with a grade of “C” or better, and ITEC 3200 – Introduction to Database with a grade of “C” or better.
- 5. The student must be in good academic standing as defined by the partner institution.

Pre-requisite Requirements

Prior to taking courses at KSU, students must have completed the following courses with a grade of “C” or better: ITEC 2140 and ITEC 3200

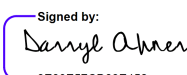

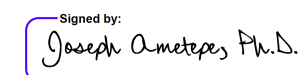
Sample Plan of Study for the BS in Information Technology to MS in Artificial Intelligence (MS AI Summer Admission)

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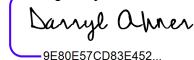
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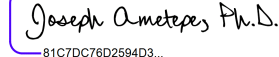
