- **1.4.2 Audio Control** – Audio objects do not play automatically by default, but this setting can be changed by the user. Make sure that this setting remains off.
- **2.2.1 Timing Adjustable**– Sections do have the option to add a timer. Make sure that this timer is set to allow minimum time to review the material and not to enforce a maximum time limit.
- **2.2.2 Pause, Stop, Hide** – Platform supports embedded video. Ensure that these embedded videos do not auto-play.
- **2.4.4 Link Purpose (In Context)** – Platform supports links to external sites. Make sure that the linked content is also accessible.

## Recommendation term definitions
