

Career Planning and Development hosted 8 career fairs this academic year leading to the following touch points:










Attendance by Classification




Self-reported Student **Preparedness**



Employer Rating of Student Professionalism






Attendees By Major





Recruitment Roles by Frequency












The largest percentage of students surveyed cited other DCPD events as the location where they learned about the fair: workshops, tabling, etc.




















Surveyed students reported speaking to an average of 5.8 employers on a visit to the fair.



Recruitment by Job Type












