STEP 2: ROOMMATE SELECTION GUIDE



HOUSING APPLICATION INITIATION FEE

Before you are able to proceed to Step 2 and 3 of the Housing application, you must pay the \$200 non-refundable Application Initiation Fee.

STEP 1:

Log in to the [Housing Portal](#) and click on the 2026-27 Application tab on the top menu, then click "continue."

STEP 2:

Please read the instructions on this page carefully as they will explain how to search for potential roommates and how to create a Roommate Pair. You may create a pair with a maximum of two people (you plus one other person).

STEP 2:

First-Year Roommate Pair

Please note this step is an optional step in the selection process. You can create a roommate pair with either incoming students you already know or recommended matches based on your profile preferences.

"Search by Details" allows you to search for roommates based on name.

"See Recommended Roommate Matches" allows you to see students that have similar preferences as you, like ideal noise levels and temperature preferences.

You are allowed to have a roommate pair with a maximum size of two people.

Please note: Room Selection timeslots open at various times for students based on when they completed their Housing Application and signed the License Agreement. We suggest that you select the person in your roommate pair who signed their License Agreement the earliest to be your roommate pair leader for the best selection of units available. The roommate pair leader will be able to place themselves, and members of the roommate pair into individual bedrooms within the unit selected when their timeslot opens. Students who are not designated as the pair leader can place themselves into a room, but do not have the ability to place other members of your roommate pair.

STEP 3:

Roommate Pair Details

On this page, you will create a Roommate Pair Name and a Roommate Pair Password that only you and your preferred roommate will know. Make sure to create a Pair Name they can easily search for (Ex: ScrappyandSturgis) and a password both of you will know (Ex: ScrappyandSturgis123!).

Then, don't forget to share the Pair Name and Password with your preferred roommate. This will allow them to join your pair. This Pair Name and Password will be used in helping you create your Roommate Pair, but will not be used again.

STEP 5:

When you have identified someone you want to live with, you will send them a request.

STEP 6:

If you receive a request, you will need to go into the portal and either accept or decline this invitation. All requests automatically expire within seven days without a response.

STEP 7:

If the person you requested accepts your invitation, you have created your Roommate Pair. Once you have two people, your group is full.

STEP 8:

If you are confident in your selection, you will be asked to save and continue, and you have completed Step 2: Roommate Selection.

The final step of the Housing Application is Step 3: Room Selection. During this last step, students can place themselves into the available rooms when their time ticket begins. Roommate Pair leaders are responsible for putting themselves and their selected preferred roommate into rooms. Students can choose to change the Roommate Pair leader in the Housing Portal at any time before Room Selection. We will have more information and guides available on our website for Step 3.
