STEP 11:

Renter's insurance is optional but highly encouraged; this will protect you from paying out-of-pocket costs if there is damage to your personal property or Housing and Residence Life's property while living on campus.

Housing Application Initiation Fee

This fee applies to students submitting a KSU Housing Application for the first time. If you have previously completed a Housing Application and paid this fee, you will not be required to pay it again.

While the \$200 nonrefundable Application Initiation Fee is not needed to finish the application, it must be paid to proceed to Step 2. After Step 11: Renters Insurance, you have the option to pay the fee right away. See the steps on how to pay!



HOW TO PAY THE APPLICATION FEE

STEP 1:

After reviewing the renter's insurance and texting preferences pages, read the "Application Initiation

Application Initiation Fee Information (\$200)

You must pay the non-refundable Application Initiation Fee in order to complete Part 1 of your Housing Application and be eligible to proceed with Roommate Selection (First-Year Students Only) and Room Selection.

This fee is non-refundable upon payment and is not a deposit. Please note that paying this fee does not guarantee that you will receive housing or receive your preferred housing community. Paying this fee allows us to assign each student a timeslot for Roommate Selection (First-Year Students Only) and Room Selection, steps 2 and 3. If you complete the Housing Application but do not pay the Application Initiation Fee, your application (step 1) is considered incomplete. You will not receive the opportunity to select roommates or a room if you do not pay this application fee.


