



Children in the University Libraries' Policy

A parent or adult caregiver must accompany children under the age of 18 (unless the minor is an enrolled KSU student) and monitor their activities and behavior while they are in the University Libraries. Library staff cannot attend to unaccompanied or unsupervised children, nor be responsible for their safety. Even under an adult's supervision, children are not allowed to use library computers.

When a child is disruptive to other patrons, the adult guardian will be asked to take the child out of the library. If the adult responsible for the child's welfare is not present, a staff member will contact the Department of Public Safety to report the situation. The child may be removed from the library by the proper authorities.
