

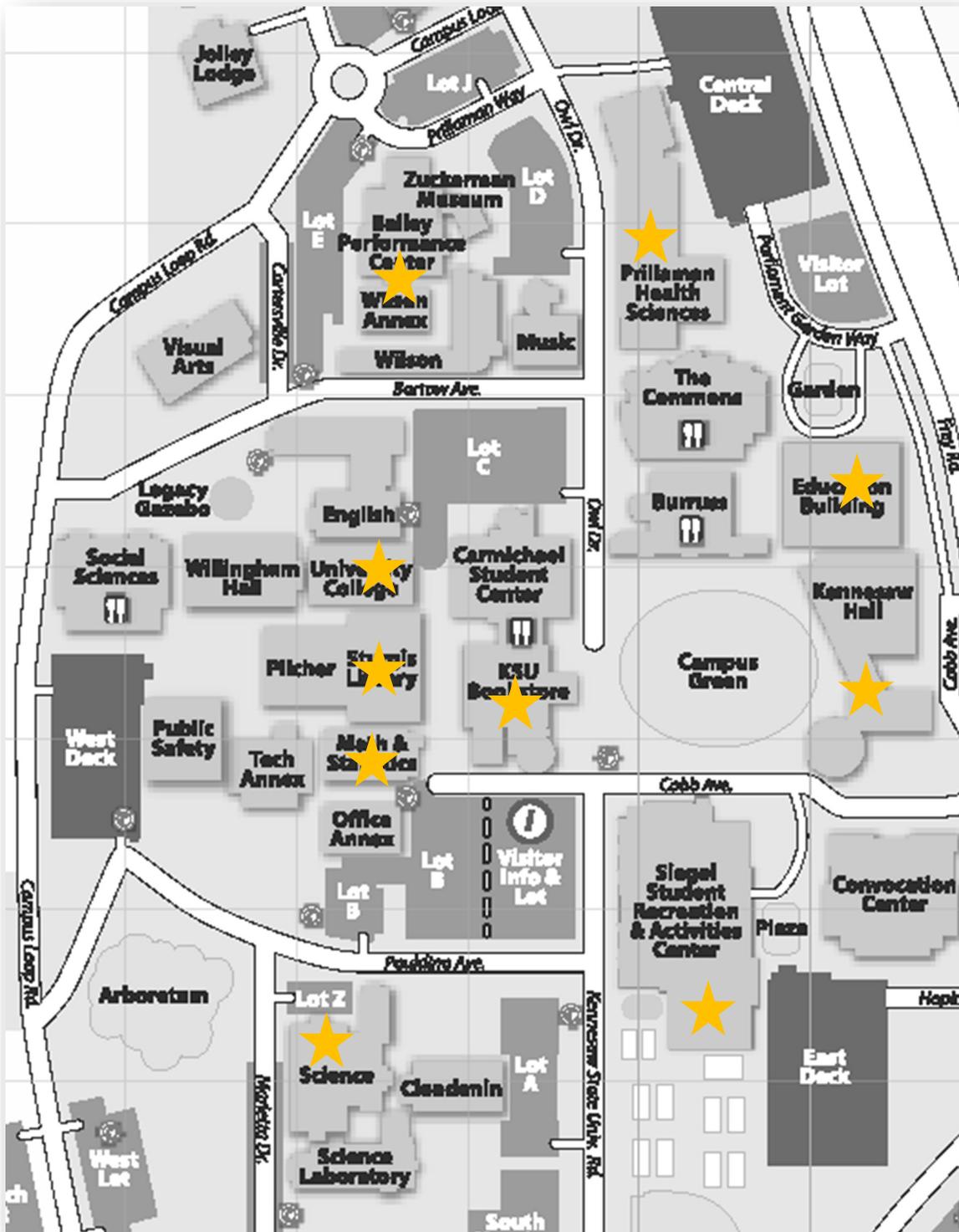
KSU Restroom Access Policy

Purpose: All members of and visitors to the KSU community should be assured equal and safe access to restrooms. Accordingly, each new building will be designed and constructed to have at least one single-occupancy, family-friendly, unisex, ADA-compliant public restroom.

Scope: Every member of the campus community will benefit from the availability of safe, comfortable, and appropriately featured restroom facilities. Implementation will primarily impact KSU Facilities as they plan, design, and execute future construction projects.

Policy: Kennesaw State University (KSU) policy is that each new building be designed and constructed to include at least one single-occupancy, family-friendly, unisex, ADA-compliant public restroom. Accessible restrooms should also be designed and constructed for all major building renovations that include extensive wall and restroom demolitions. Any waiver or variance from this policy requires written approval from the KSU president. Existing restroom modifications and upgrades to improve accessibility for those with mobility impairments may be made without building a new single-occupancy restroom. A KSU priority is to increase the number of policy-compliant restrooms along with the growth of the campus community.

- 1 total: 1st floor, Administration Side

University College

- 1 total: 2nd Floor

Wilson Annex

- 2 gendered single stall restrooms on 2nd floor

Prillaman Hall

- 2 total: 1st & 2nd floor, near northwest stairs

Recreation Center

- Gender Neutral Locker Room & Showers; next to pool entrance
- 1 in hall off of Campus Green entrance

Education Building

- Second Floor, Suite 225, Center for Literacy & Learning

Sturgis Library

- 1st floor, in corners near women's restroom
